<u>Feast of Corpus Christi</u> – Procession was well attended and was a visible sign to the community of our faith and that the Eucharist is important to us.

<u>St. Marthas Parking Lot</u> – Permission was received from the Archbishop to do the paving work. All final legal matters and details of paving work are being resolved. Fr. Golas addressed questions and concerns from Council members.

<u>St. Adalberts Sale</u> (with additional comments from Dcn. Paul Robert) – Majority of the funds from sale (around \$564,000) went into endowment fund.

<u>Duplex at St. Patrick's</u> – Permission has been given to market the property. Property is empty and largely in good condition due to renovation work.

<u>Parish Center and old Convent</u> – Still looking at options of how to disposition the property. The insurance company would like to settle the claim for the freeze damage. Repair of the damage is estimated at \$90,000. The finance committee is looking at the options.

<u>Parish Picnic</u> – Kristen brought up the need for volunteers, and a reminder that the Parish Council is the host for the event and that all members should look to participate in running the picnic. Fr. Golas echoed Kristens views, and stressed importance of everyone contributing to the effort.
